About Nonprofit Day

Nonprofit Day is a full-day educational conference for nonprofit staff and volunteer leadership that attracts more than 300 attendees each year. This annual event provides a much-needed opportunity for the nonprofit community to come together to learn how to advance their organizations and the nonprofit sector. Keynotes and sessions throughout the day follow four thematic tracks: management & leadership, governance, fundraising, and marketing & communications.

The 19th annual Nonprofit Day will take place on Tuesday, October 29, 2019 at the Bayfront Convention Center in Erie, PA.

DEMOGRAPHIC INFORMATION



Attendees

Supporting Nonprofit Day as a sponsor or exhibitor gives you face-to-face access to hundreds of nonprofit sector decision makers. In 2018, Nonprofit Day boasted **309 attendees from the nonprofit sector**.

Title

Of these attendees, 21% were Executive Directors or CEOs and 29% held Chief-, Vice President-, or Director-level titles. Taken together, **exactly half of all attendees occupied executive-level staff positions within their organizations**.

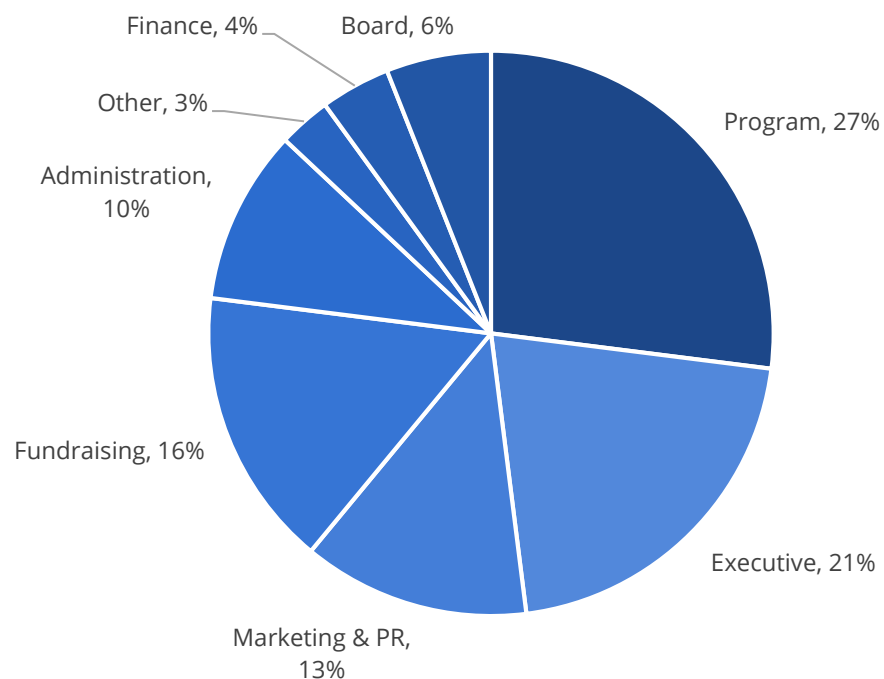

Specialty

Attendees at Nonprofit Day also come from a wide range of specialties, as illustrated in the chart at right. In 2018, slightly more than one quarter of attendees were program staff. Executive Directors and CEOs, marketing and PR staff, and fundraisers were also very well represented.

Attendees at Nonprofit Day 2018 by Specialty

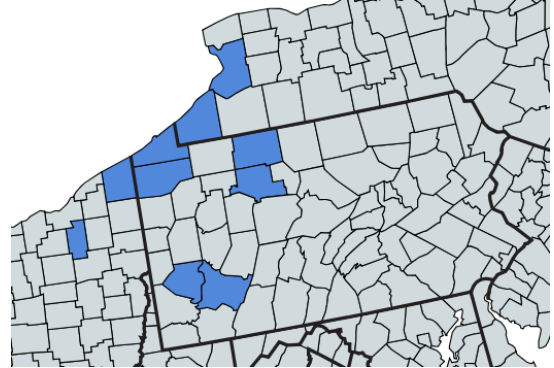


Organizations

Nonprofit Day is attended by a significant number of organizations each year. The 2018 conference was attended by **143 unique organizations**.

Location

Organizations from 10 counties in Pennsylvania, New York, and Ohio were represented at Nonprofit Day 2018. Counties represented include Allegheny County (PA), Ashtabula County (OH), Chautauqua County (NY), Crawford County (PA), Elk County (PA), Erie County (PA), Erie County (NY), McKean County (PA), Summit County (OH), and Westmoreland County (PA).

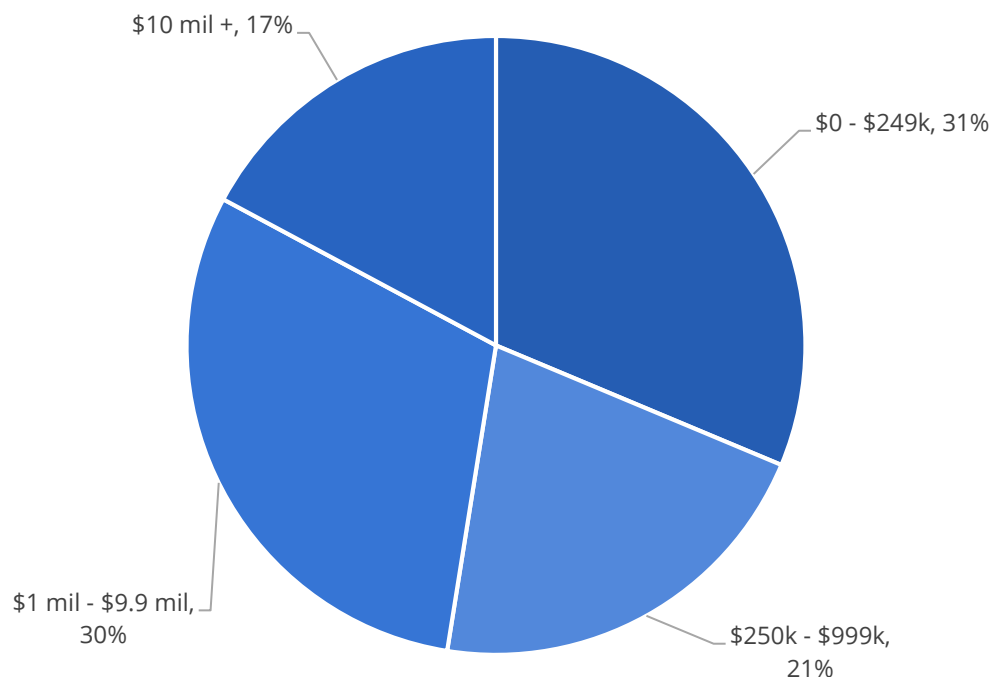


Budget Size

Nonprofit Day attendees come from organizations of all budget sizes. At Nonprofit Day 2018, 31% of organizations represented had budgets between \$0 and \$249,999; 21% had budgets between \$250,000 and \$999,999; 30% had budgets between \$1 million and \$9.99 million; and 17% had budgets of \$10 million or more.

These numbers are largely in line with findings that suggest that the majority of nonprofits nationally have budgets of less than \$1 million per year.

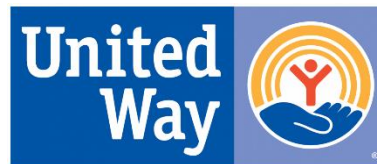

DETAILS & FAQs

What's a conference bag?

Each attendee receives a conference bag after they've checked in to the conference and picked up their lanyard. These bags are a convenient way for attendees to manage all of the handouts (and promotional goodies) they'll receive throughout the day.

Conference bags include a folder, a conference program book, an Exhibitor Card (more on that later) and various promotional items from Nonprofit Day sponsors and exhibitors.



What counts as a "small promotional item"?

If you'd like to include an item in attendees' bags, it must be:

1. Small. Items should not exceed the size of a standard water bottle. They need to fit into the conference bag and should be light enough to be carried around all day. When it doubt, the smaller, the better.
2. Useful. Examples of accepted items include pens, notepads, thumb drives, and stress balls.

You are, of course, welcome (and encouraged!) to display printed marketing materials at your exhibitor table (or distribute them to session attendees if you are a Session Sponsor).

However, **we will not include promotional flyers, brochures, booklets, or any other printed collateral in conference bags.**

How many promotional items will I need?

Please plan to provide approximately 425 items.

Unused items may be returned to your company on the day of the conference (if a company representative is present) or retained and used for future NPP programming, depending on your preference.

I've decided on my promotional item. Now what?

Now you'll just need to deliver your items to NPP so that we can place them into the conference bags for you.

Items must be delivered to The Nonprofit Partnership by no later than 4:30 PM on October 18, 2019. The Nonprofit Partnership is located at 609 Walnut Street, Erie, PA 16502.

What's the Exhibitor Card drawing?

To further increase attendees' engagement with Exhibitors, we introduced the Exhibitor Card drawing.

Each attendee receives an Exhibitor Card in their conference bag. Exhibitor Cards have the name of each Exhibitor printed on them.

Attendees can enter to win one of several prizes by having their cards stamped by a given number of Exhibitors, then dropping their completed card into a box at The Nonprofit Partnership's table.

Winners are drawn at the conference reception.

All exhibitors and all sponsors that choose to have an exhibitor table are automatically listed on the card.

What makes the Exhibitor card so great?

We're glad you asked! Our exhibitors love the Exhibitor Card because it encourages attendees to strike up conversations with *you*, thereby increasing contacts made and leads generated – all without any extra effort! (Plus, who doesn't like prizes?)

I want to provide a prize for the Exhibitor Card drawing. Are there any guidelines or restrictions I should be aware of?

Prizes are meant to be enjoyed by the individual attendee, not the organization they represent. **We will not accept coupons, vouchers for free consultations, free business services packages, or any other things of this nature.**

Some examples of past prizes include a Fitbit, a Google Home, a VISA gift card, and a flat screen TV. Prizes typically fall within the \$50 to \$150 range.

Prizes may be delivered to The Nonprofit Partnership by 4:30 PM on October 18, 2019. The Nonprofit Partnership is located at 609 Walnut Street, Erie, PA 16502.

If you prefer, you may also bring your prize to the Bayfront Convention Center on October 29, 2019.

Who can use my company's complimentary conference registrations?

Complimentary conference registrations may be used by staff of your company or they may be transferred to the Nonprofit Day scholarship pool.

When an individual applies for a Nonprofit Day scholarship, they fill out an application. If their application is approved and they receive a scholarship, they will be notified that their scholarship was made possible by your company's generous contribution.

How can I access my company's complimentary conference registrations?

When your company signs up as a sponsor, you'll receive a unique promo code via email. Employees may then register for the conference online and enter the promo code at checkout to redeem your company's complimentary registrations.

Registrations must be completed by Friday, October 11. After this date, any unused registrations will automatically be donated to the Nonprofit Day scholarship pool.

What is the Nonprofit Day scholarship pool and how does it work?

Each sponsor receives complimentary conference registrations as a part of their benefit package. Any unused registrations will be transferred to the Nonprofit Day scholarship pool.

New for 2019, the scholarship pool is a way for those who might not have otherwise been able to attend Nonprofit Day to join us at the conference, free of charge!

Interested staff, Board members, and volunteers can apply for a Nonprofit Day scholarship. Once applications have been reviewed to ensure applicants meet certain eligibility requirements, recipients will be selected by lottery.

Scholarship recipients will be notified that they have been awarded a Nonprofit Day scholarship on Monday, October 14.

When your company's registration is awarded to a scholarship recipient, they will be informed that your company's generosity has made their scholarship possible. (For example, if your company donates four registrations, four individuals will be informed that their scholarships were made possible by your company. Your company will be recognized on an individual basis, rather than in aggregate.)

I'm attending Nonprofit Day as an exhibitor. Can I sit in on a few sessions?

You can attend sessions only if you have registered as an attendee using one of your company's complimentary conference registrations.

I've registered as an Exhibitor. When can I set up my table?

Exhibitors set up the morning of the event. The doors to the Bayfront Convention Center will be open by 6:45 AM. We ask that you please have your table set up by the time attendees begin to arrive at 7:30 AM.

I see that the Premier Event and Friend of Nonprofit Day sponsorships are included as a part of some Associate Memberships. Where can I find more information about this?
